## Pros tip of the month

“Course Management – All the major trouble off the tee around Wrekin is on the left hand side of the hole as we play it (both sides on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> holes). Sometimes it's how good our bad shots are and if the ball is still in play. If we miss the fairway to the right on 13<sup>th</sup> we are still in play.....miss it to the left and we are Out of Bounds & picking another ball out of our bags! Before your tee shot, figure out which is the safest side of the hole to play to and you might be able to eliminate those wasted shots off the tee.”

## Windfall

The committee are exploring an opportunity to re-lease the telephone mast at the bottom of the drive. Current investigations are indicating that the revenue could potentially be circa £48K. In addition we are pursuing a claim via KPMG for a VAT rebate on subscriptions paid over the last few years. We estimate that this may be worth circa £30K. In both cases, if we are successful the plan is to use this revenue to support capital projects.
