## **WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM - WHS**

WHS takes effect from 2nd November 2020 and supersedes the CONGU system.

Your Committee is supporting **Club Policy** by encouraging Members to have **20 x SCORE DIFFERENTIALS** [Qualifying Rounds] in place by the end of October this year.

COME NOVEMBER, YOUR 'HANDICAP INDEX' WILL BECOME THE AVERAGE OF THE LOWEST 8 of YOUR 20 MOST RECENT 'SCORE DIFFERENTIALS'.

Although some Members took steps towards achieving this goal through Competition and Supplementary Rounds during the 2019 Season, many of us still have a fairly long way to go - **BUT IT CAN BE DONE - AND WILL BE WORTHWHILE -** particularly for those of us who enjoy playing on neighbouring courses, with a different 'Slope Rating' [difficulty factor] than Wrekin.

A 'SCORE DIFFERENTIAL' can be recorded over 9 or 18 holes, providing it's played within the Rules of Golf and in an 'Authorised Format' - which includes ORGANISED COMPETITION or PRE-REGISTERED GENERAL PLAY - CAN BE EITHER 'MEDAL' OR 'STABLEFORD' - provided that it's an INDIVIDUAL SCORE based PERSONAL PERFORMANCE - so, for example, Pairs Competition, Match Play and Scrambles are excluded. Scores achieved over 9 holes are automatically 'doubled-up' to represent an 18 hole round.

Scores achieved in SINGLES COMPETITION ROUNDS MUST BE RECORDED, whilst those resulting from Pre-Registered Social or General Play are ACCEPTABLE [Organised 'Roll-Up's can be deemed Pre-Registered - otherwise Register in Golf Reception beforehand [as now]

When a 'Round' is entered into the Computer, software will automatically generate a 'Score Differential' based on the Member's Adjusted Gross Score, and take into account the Course and Slope Rating. It will identify the lowest 8 of the 20 MOST RECENT 'Score Differentials' and allocate the Member's CURRENT 'Handicap Index' - bear in mind that the process is dynamic and that 'Round 21' will become 'Round 20' when the 'earliest' [Round 1] 'falls-off the system' and is no longer part of the '20 MOST RECENT' calculation.

So, a Member's 'Handicap Index' will fluctuate, dependant on adjustments applied when a new 'Score Differential' is recorded.

In effect, the Computer Software does the work - and the Member's only responsibility is to enter their Gross Score into the Computer, Hole by Hole, and check their Handicap Index before their next round [via the Computer Terminal, HowDidIDo or England Golf]

One of the undoubted **BENEFITS of WHS** is the introduction of a 'SLOPE RATING' which is based on DIFFICULTIES PRESENTED BY EACH COURSE. A 'COURSE HANDICAP' LOOK- UP TABLE will be available at EACH CLUB AND WILL CONVERT A PLAYER'S 'HOME 'HANDICAP INDEX' INTO A 'PLAYING HANDICAP' FOR THE COURSE BEING PLAYED.

## HOW WILL OUR SECTION HELP MEMBERS ACHIEVE 20 RECENT 'SCORE DIFFERENTIAL' BY THE END OF THE 2020 SEASON?

We have about 60 or so active Members - with about 30-35 playing in competitions most weeks. We were scheduled to hold 12 x 15 hole and 6 x 18 hole 'Board' Competitions during the forthcoming 'season', plus 7 x 15 hole Winter Stablefords, the Thursday 'Roll-Up' and a few Texas Scrambles. **Winter Golf will remain unchanged.** 

WHS recognises 9 hole Rounds as acceptable 'Score Differentials' - in fact, a 'Handicap Index' could be based ENTIRELY on 9 hole Golf! Whilst this may be an acceptable, painless and fairly quick way of building a 'Handicap Index' - there is a DOWNSIDE, particularly here at Wrekin, where it's fairly well accepted that the FRONT 9 is EASIER, AND LESS PHYSICALLY DEMANDING, THAN THE BACK 9 - PRODUCING LOWER SCORES - and therefore a LOWER 'HANDICAP INDEX' than might be the case if the Member completed FULL and CONTINUOUS ROUNDS of 18 HOLES.

Taking all things into account, the Seniors Committee have decided that for the 2020 Playing Season at least, the 6 rounds of the 'Parton Jamieson' Trophy will be played over 18 holes, rather than 15, supplementing the 6 x 18 hole rounds of the 'Derek Taylor' Trophy. This will give Members the potential to play 12 x 18 hole rounds of Senior 'Board' Competition [off Club Handicap] towards their 20 'Score Differentials'

There will still be 7 x 15 hole competitions, played off Seniors Handicap and scored on the Seniors 'Card'. However, Dave Pegge will enter the Members GROSS SCORE FOR THEIR 'FRONT 9' onto their 'Playing Record' and THESE 9 HOLE ROUNDS will form part of their 20 'Score Differentials.'

Members are also reminded that they CAN, if they so wish, play the 15th, 16th and 17th as additional holes during a 15 hole competition round - in which case they should complete both their 15 hole card AND an 18 hole card. The latter will take precedence over the 15 hole card for the purpose of recording a 'Score Differential' - but should always be Pre-Registered as such.
