

Guidance for Visitors

Dress Code

Please avoid extremes of dress.

No Trainers, Hoodies or Football replica shirts to be worn

Recognised golf attire must be worn on the course.

Spikeless Golf shoes may be worn in the Club House.

Before Your Visit

Always check to ensure the course is open in times of inclement weather by calling 01952 244032 Option 5 for course conditions.

Before Play

Golf shoes should be changed in the Club House changing rooms, not the car park.

Report to the Golf Reception before start of play.

Play should only commence from the first tee unless advised by the Golf Reception Staff.

Observe your allocated start time.

Gents are to play from the yellow tees unless otherwise agreed.

Ladies have their own tees.

Remember to repair pitch marks, replace divots and rake bunkers; and do not take trolleys onto the tees, greens or green surrounds, or between greens and greenside bunkers.

Players should be aware of others on the course and not hold up play of those behind - ALWAYS ENSURE YOU KEEP UP WITH GROUP IN FRONT.

Club members taking part in Club Competitions or matches have priority on the course and should be invited through.

Each hole, apart from par 3's, has a 150 distance marker to the side of the fairway measuring to the centre of the green.

Buggies

Do not drive buggies onto tees or green surrounds, do not drive up to 13th tee access paths are too severe.

General

Alcohol is not permitted anywhere on the course.

Mobile Phones may be used in the Club House for reference purposes and messaging , but calls to and from must be taken on the balcony. Due consideration to others must be taken at all times.
